





2. The economic value of social care

Recommendations

- Detailed description: This is a mass spectrum plot with the x-axis representing the mass-to-charge ratio (m/z) from 100 to 1000, and the y-axis representing relative abundance from 0 to 100%. The base peak (100% relative abundance) is at m/z 500. Other major peaks are labeled with their m/z values. The spectrum shows a complex pattern of ions, with several groups of peaks appearing at regular intervals of 14 units, characteristic of a cyclic peptide.
